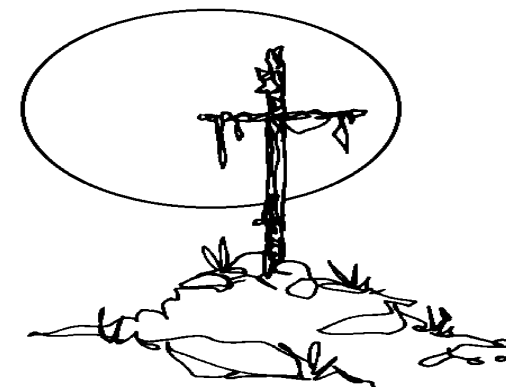

HEALING THROUGH THE EUCHARISTIC

Have you ever wondered what it would have been like to be the woman who touched the hem of Jesus' garment? Well you have the chance to experience that for yourself. All you need to do is come and experience one of the Eucharistic Healing Services presented by Dr. Bob and Anita Rice. They are members of the Archdiocesan Service Committee for Charismatic Renewal and avid supporters of the Renewal.

Unlike most healing services, Dr. Bob and Anita do not lay hands on the people who come for prayer. They believe in leading the people to Jesus for their healing. This is the way their Eucharistic Healing Service is presented:

Dr. Bob presents a message on Expectant Faith.

The Blessed Sacrament is exposed and a cloth is placed around the base of the monstrance which becomes the hem of His garment. All the proper songs and ceremony are done for proper exposition.

A beautiful song called "I am a voice crying for mercy" is sung.

Then the Chaplet of Divine Mercy is done. During this time the people need to be praying and calling out to the Lord for their healing.

Then the Gregorian chant is played. It is at this time that the people come and take hold of the hem of the Lord's garment and receive their healing from the Lord.

After everyone has had their moment with the Lord and touching the hem of His garment, Benediction is done to close the service.

Here is one example of the type of healings that have taken place in their Eucharistic Healing Services. A man who had fallen off the back of a truck landed on a big ball of keys in his pocket. When he was operated on, he ended up missing 4 inches of bone in his leg and a steel rod was placed in his leg. When the man came and touched the hem of the Lord's garment he received a touch from the Lord. In seventeen days the 4 inches of bone missing in his leg grew back together and the steel rod disappeared.
