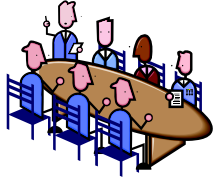

SHARING AND PRAYING THE GOOD NEWS: *What Do We Proclaim?*

- 1) **God's Love:** God so loved the world that he sent us his only beloved Son. Jesus loved us so much that he gave his life for us. When we know we are loved we feel secure. However, human love is imperfect. Only God's perfect love gives us true freedom and security. Help the person to get to know and meet the person of Jesus and his love for them. Ask if they would like to experience this love.
- 2) **Salvation Through Jesus Christ:** Jesus took all our sins and wounds upon himself to save us from our sins. By his wounds we are healed! Receiving salvation involves repentance and faith. In repentance we invite people to tell Jesus that we are sorry for going our own direction in life, and now choose to follow him and go in his direction. We invite a person to ask forgiveness for one's particular sins and to choose to forgive those who have sinned against them, since Jesus forgave us from the cross. We invite the person to make a commitment of faith: Believing in Jesus and what he has accomplished for us; trusting oneself to him as his disciple; and expecting him to do in me all that he promised.
- 3) **New Life in the Spirit:** Jesus' ways are too hard for us by human efforts alone. We need the Holy Spirit who gives us divine love, power, guidance and wisdom. Jesus gave us the Holy Spirit as our Advocate, Counselor, Comforter, and Power from on High. We have the Holy Spirit in us through baptism, but we are called to "*stir into a flame*" this gift. We invite a person to ask for the gift of the Spirit and let go of seeking to control one's life by oneself. We can say, "*May I pray with you for this renewal in the Spirit, which Scripture calls being baptized in the Spirit.*"

How Do We Pray?

- 1) **Do not rush into prayer:** Say to the person, "*let us ask the Lord how we are to pray.*" Praise God; pray in tongues; wait for a sense of the Holy Spirit's presence and anointing. Otherwise we tend to just give encouraging words. We need to face our temptation to pray in the flesh, rather than in the Spirit. Here are some examples of fleshly prayer:
 - a) Quick responders whose minds are sparked quickly by one idea sparking another idea, or people with active imaginations. These people can go on too long in prayer and the effectiveness is lessened.
 - b) Wanting others to feel my immediate love and concern leads to praying too quickly.
 - c) Wanting people to see me as "*capable.*" We feel that if we do not say something quick they may think that we do not know what we are doing.
 - d) Feeling "*left out*" if others praying with me for someone are saying a lot, so I feel that I have to come up with something.
 - e) Wanting to get an inspired "*word*" for someone so much that I share something I remember from the past (that did not come as an inspiration).
 - f) Liking the attention I am getting from the person that I am praying with.
- 2) **Pray for them to experience God's love.** Invite them to accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior and pray for them to receive Jesus' saving, forgiving and healing touch. Invite them to give Jesus all their sins, wounds, and fears, so he can release them and fill them with his presence. Ask them if they want to surrender the direction of their life to the Holy Spirit. If they say yes, pray for them to be baptized in the Spirit as a renewal of the graces of their Sacramental Baptism.
- 3) **Pray for people's ongoing growth in the Lord.** Do not let people focus on just getting rid of problems. Exhort and encourage them to become all that God wants them to be. Pray for empowerment for their daily life and service to others. Pray with them for God's direction for their vocation and service. Invite them to offer their abilities, responsibilities and callings to the Lord, so that he can empower these with spiritual gifts in which they will experience the Holy Spirit working through them for others.

PENTECOST TODAY

We have been blessed in the United States with a vibrant group of people who, since the 2nd Vatican Council, have worked to help renew the grace of Pentecost in the life and mission of the Church. There is so much to learn and experience in the new life of the renewal movement and the National Service committee has worked to bring us up to date with what the Vatican and the worldwide Renewal is doing in support of the Charismatic Renewal in the Church.

One of the tools is the quarterly "Pentecost Today" publication by the National Service Committee. Although we recommend it for everyone, at least the leaders and core groups should have it as a reference booklet. You may give talks on the subjects covered or share it with your groups. Also the Archdiocese Charisletter has information about upcoming events, topics about the Renewal, formation and training workshops and calendar of events.

Other tools are the workshops given by the Renewal Center. Only a small number of prayer groups are represented at these teachings and oftentimes leaders don't attend. Let us not stifle the workings of the Holy Spirit. He is talking to us in many different ways and I highly recommend that each group receive the Pentecost Today magazine and share it with your groups.

Remember the prayer we used to use regularly, "Renew us oh Lord, as in a new Pentecost."? He is here! And He expects us to respond with a fresh zeal and anointing so we can share with others! He expects the fruits of the Spirit to be evident in us: love, joy, peace, patient, kind, goodness, faithfulness, humility, and self-control. (Gal. 5:22-23) He also expects us to share what we have learned and experienced, like the gifts of the Holy Spirit. (1Cor. 12)

The Pentecost Today rekindles the fire of the Spirit! We don't want to fall into the category of Revelation 2:2-4: "I know your works, your toil and your patient endurance. I know that you cannot tolerate evildoers; you have tested those who claim to be apostles but are not, and have found them to be false. I also know that you are enduring patiently and bearing up for the sake of my name, and that you have not grown weary. But I have this against you: that you have abandoned the love you had at first."

Brothers and sisters: Let us regain the zeal we had in the beginning. The Holy Spirit is the same, yesterday, today and forever. Be open to Him and He will renew us as in a new Pentecost.
