Excerpts of the *Course on Charismatic Discipleship* from Fr. Bob Hogan, BBD.

From The Staff

“Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavens” (Eph. 1:3). Our conference was truly filled with spiritual blessings! We thank God for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, and we are thankful for all the people who served the Lord in making it such a blessing. Many people spoke positively about the conference being at St. Mary Magdalen Church. Our plan is to have it there next year. Let us continue to seek the fire of the Holy Spirit. Sister Nancy told us that you start a fire with:

- 1) Paper which burns quickly, but not very long (the intoxicating power and presence of the Spirit which we need to continually renew); then add
- 2) Wood (daily prayer life, Scripture, Sacraments, using the charisms); then add
- 3) Coal (letting the Spirit purify us; teach us wisdom and maturity in our daily lives); and
- 4) Pile the coals so they are all interconnected (growing as a community that demonstrates God’s love and learns how to work together in honesty and unity).

In this way we will continue to grow as DUI’s (“Disciples Under the Influence” of the Holy Spirit). Do you sense the call to support the work of charismatic renewal in the Archdiocese of San Antonio? We need leadership in our prayer groups (present and future leadership) that seeks and follows the guidance and wisdom of the Spirit in taking practical steps for the group’s ongoing growth. The Prayer Group Training sessions on “Raising Up Prophets and Leaders” (March 29 and April 5 from 9-4 at CCCR) are one way to continue to grow in this practical wisdom. It is important that present leaders know how to help people to grow in prophetic/inspirational gifts in their group, and know how to raise up new leadership so the group can continue, and grow even stronger. If you cannot attend these sessions, please contact Fr. Bob so that he (and a team from the Center) can work with your group. I strongly encourage the core leadership of prayer groups to seek the help that we can give you from the Center.

Finally, on Saturday, April 26 at 6:00 p.m. (Song and Praise at 5:45 pm.) at St. Mary Magdalen Church Fr. George Montague and Fr. Bob Hogan will be celebrating their 50th and 25th anniversaries as priests with a Mass, and a reception afterwards in the Church Hall. Bishop Tom Flanagan will be the main celebrant for the Mass. Fr. George and Fr. Bob are inviting all of you who have been a support to us, to the Brothers of the Beloved Disciple, and to the Charismatic Renewal to join us for this celebration. We would love to have you come to celebrate with us God’s faithfulness and goodness. No RSVP is needed.

- 4) We are “baptized in the Holy Spirit” through the Messiah (Christ-Anointed One), Jesus (Luke 3: 15-16; Acts 1: 4-5).
- 5) Reveals God’s love, creating union with God (Romans 5: 5; Ephesians 3:14-19).
- 6) Makes Scripture come alive (John 14:25-26; Luke 24:44-49; Eph. 6:17).
- 7) Gives charisms/spiritual gifts (Romans 12:3-8; 1 Cor. 12 & 14; Eph. 4:11-16).
- 8) Gives prophetic inspirations (Luke 1:46-55; 67-79; 1 Cor. 14:2 Peter 1:19-21).
- 9) Gives healing gifts (Luke 10:1-9; 1 Cor. 12: 28; Acts 3:1-10).
- 10) Gives “messianic gifts” (Isaiah 11:1-9).
- 11) Gives evangelization gifts (Isaiah 61:1-3; Luke 4:16-21).
- 12) Makes us holy
- 13) Teaches us to pray (Romans 8:26-27).
- 14) Inspires us to praise God (Acts 2:3-4, 11; & 10:44-46).
- 15) Intercedes within us (Romans 8:26-27)
- 16) Overcomes the world, the flesh, and the devil (John 16:7-11; Gal. 5:16-26).
- 17) Gives the “fruit of the Spirit” (Gal. 5:22-23).
- 18) Guides and gives wisdom (Wisdom 7:7; 1 Cor. 2:6-16).
- 19) Convicts us of sin and convinces us of Jesus’ victory over sin (John 16:7-11)
- 20) Our advocate/companion/partner (John 14: 15-18, 25-27; 15:26-27; 16:5-15).
- 21) Makes us “anointed ones” with Jesus (1 John 2: 24-27).

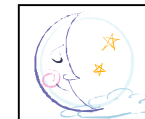
