From The Staff:

The first of the 4 workshops for our Fall Series on ***“Practical Evangelization Tools and Training”*** will be **Saturday, September 26, 2009 from 10:00 am. to 12:30 pm.** at the Catholic Center for Charismatic Renewal. The theme will be ***“Worship Leading That Evangelizes.”***

Everyone who is involved with the leading of Praise and Worship in prayer groups should attend. We encourage all the prayer group leaders to bring a core group of people from your prayer group. Every prayer group needs a core group of strong worshippers that is able to draw newer people into Praise and Worship. Praise and Worship opens us to the activity and gifts of the Spirit. Your prayer group will be greatly strengthened if a group of you attend this workshop together. You will grow in these areas:

- 1) The purpose of Praise and Worship (Scripture and Catechism).
- 2) Types of Praise and Worship.
- 3) Creating an atmosphere that welcomes the presence of the Holy Spirit.
- 4) The relationship of songs of praise and verbal praise without music.
- 5) Tools for helping your members grow in a lifestyle of praise and worship.
- 6) The importance of the Word of Wisdom for Praise Leaders.
- 7) Practical ways of drawing the group into praise and worship.
- 8) The relationship of the Praise Leader and the Music Leader.
- 9) How Praise leads to the manifestation of Prophetic gifts.
- 10) How new people can experience that *“the Lord is truly in your midst.”*

Again, **this will be most powerful for your group if the Praise Leaders come with a number of people from your group** so you can develop a core of strong worshippers.

We are excited to again co-sponsor with City Pact (formerly TransformSA) the ecumenical ***“Church of the City Conference”***, (October 2-4 at Abundant Life Church, 5626 Randolph Blvd. 78233) on the theme: **Transformation by the Renewal of our Minds...for our City, our neighborhoods, our Families, and Ourselves.** There is no registration for the conference. Love offerings will be taken. Sessions will be Friday from 7:00 pm to 9:30 pm; Saturday from 9:30 am to 12:00 noon, and 6:30 pm. to 9:30 pm; and Sunday from 6:30 pm. to 9:30 pm. **Charles Whitehead from England will again be the featured speaker.** He is the former chairperson for the International Office for the Catholic Charismatic Renewal in Rome. We were very blessed by him last year. I (Fr. Bob) will also be speaking.

Building on last year’s conference, we began monthly intercession nights for the city on the first Tuesdays of the month at CCCR with over 40 people attending regularly. We have had two pastors meetings to build greater unity and understanding, and we have supported other joint efforts with City Pact. Last year we had a very good turn out from the Catholic Charismatic Renewal. Get the word out. Invite people to come with you. This will be a great time of grace. Let’s not miss this opportunity. As I am writing this, we do not yet have the information brochures, but I hope that we will have them in time to include with this newsletter.

1) September 26, 2009: Worship Leading that Evangelizes. St. Paul says that when people come to prayer groups their hearts should be touched and they will declare, “God is really in your midst” (1 Cor 14:24-25). Understanding the prayer of praise and worship, and how to help groups to grow in true worship of God that opens them to God’s presence and the Holy Spirit.

2) October 17, 2009: Prayer Ministry for Evangelization. Praying with people for a personal commitment to Christ, for baptism in the Spirit, for the gift of tongues, for others charisms/spiritual gifts, for the empowerment of the Holy Spirit, for God’s calling and direction in their lives, etc.

3) October 31, 2009: Intercession Opening Doors for Evangelization. Calling all intercessors! We need you! Learning the power of intercession to overcome obstacles to God’s work. Learn to be guided by the Spirit in what to intercede for and how to intercede (for individuals, families, churches, neighborhoods, our city, etc.). The power of united group intercession.

4) November 7, 2009: Today’s Moral Issues and Evangelization. How can we talk with people about moral issues like abortion, homosexuality, pre-marital sex, pornography, greed, etc. in a way that can help them come

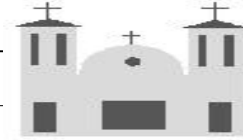

Dan Dúet calls San Antonio home. One summer he shared his songs during a retreat and found that through song he could connect with an audience. He also realized that the Holy Spirit could minister to that same audience through him. Dan totally embraced the concept of music as a ministry. As his spiritual life continued to grow, so too did his songwriting. Dan released his first demo titled, "Come to the Cross". It would be the beginning of a long journey of understanding how the Christian music industry works, of how his fellow Catholics relate to contemporary Christian music, and of the rigors of being a (music) minister. Dan has been both presenter and music minister for various Regional/National events related to various Catholic organizations including Youth, Marian, Charismatic, and Married Couples. Dan has also appeared on local Christian radio and one of his concerts was taped and aired on Catholic Television of San Antonio, the first "television special" for CTSA. Dan recently won the 2008 Unity Award for the "Country Song of the Year, Traces of Jesus". Dan thanked God with this quote: "The event was exciting, with or without an award, but how sweet to pick up such a great souvenir while I was on tour"! GO AND MAKE DISCIPLES

We are blessed to have people proclaiming the word of God in the Archdiocese and we thank you for obeying the Lord's calling to "**go and make disciples.**" With this in mind, we must ensure that each one has fulfilled all the requirements to be able to serve in the Archdiocese and beyond. Following are some of the requirements:

You must have completed the Archdiocesan "Policy on Sexual Misconduct" course. We have the DVD and booklet at the CCCR. If you attended a course in your parish or at the Archdiocese you may bring a copy of the course completion and a letter from your pastor that states you are in good standing in the Church.

You must submit a "Criminal Background Search Authorization & Release Form". If you completed one in your parish, bring a copy to the CCCR and a letter from your pastor that states you have completed the course and that you are in good standing in the Church. Background checks are good for three years and then must be resubmitted.

Bring certificates of courses completed (if any) that qualify you to serve as an evangelist. You must be in good standing in your parish and the Church; have attended a Life in the Spirit Seminar, Spiritual Growth courses and belong to a charismatic prayer group.

To receive a letter of recommendation you must be involved in the Charismatic Renewal in the Archdiocese, attend and support our activities such as conferences, days of renewal, seminars, etc; agree with the vision and mission statement; subscribe for the Charisletter and support the CCCR with your gifts, time and treasure. Your presence and support at renewal activities is of the essence.

Brothers and sisters, let us "show the way" by working together in obedience to the prerequisites and to ensure that only qualified evangelists are representing the Church. Let us work as one as we "**go and make disciples.**"
