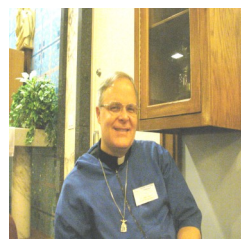

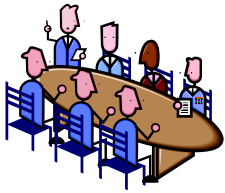

PENTECOST FIRE: I hope that your celebration of Pentecost has given you a new zeal and commitment to continue the work of the Charismatic Renewal to be a reminder in the Church of the importance of the Holy Spirit. How wonderful to have a personal Advocate given to us by Jesus to empower us, inspire us, fill us with love, joy, peace, and give us spiritual gifts to serve the Church and evangelize the world!

JESUS' HEART TO SERVE: June 11 is the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and June 12 is the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Our monthly Evening of Renewal (Saturday, June 12, 2010 at 7:00 pm.) will be on the theme, *"Serving with the Heart of Jesus"*. It will take place at St. Philip of Jesus Church which is at S. Flores and Lambert Streets, just about a mile from St. Henry's and the Charismatic Center (Lambert St. is on the left when you drive south on S. Flores from the Center). This will be a bilingual event sponsored by the Zone 4 prayer groups under the leadership of the St. Philip of Jesus Prayer Group. Fr. Will Combs, BBD will be the speaker. Both English and Spanish Groups are invited. Every group that attends will receive special prayers so they can serve with the heart of Jesus. Come to receive the tremendous grace of doing everything in your life with the heart of Jesus! Remember to invite someone to come with you.

PRAYER MINISTRY TRAINING: In July we will be starting a 10 week training program called *"Prayer Ministry for Healing and Empowerment"*. The meetings will be twice a month between July and November (July 10, 24; August 14, 28; September 11, 25; October 9, 23; November 13, 20) at the Catholic Center for Charismatic Renewal from 10 am to noon. There will be both English and Spanish sessions. This is required training for anyone doing prayer ministry with the Catholic Center for Charismatic Renewal and for Prayer Groups and Ministries that are related to the Center. We want everyone involved in prayer ministry to have a certificate showing that they have gone through a training program. To receive the certificate a person must attend at least 7 of the 10 sessions and get the notes from any missed classes. Even if you have gone through training at the Center in the past, we want everyone to attend. In next month's newsletter we will give you all the information and topics for the sessions. We will have a variety of presenters. I (Fr. Bob) will be overseeing the program and signing the certificates. Prayer ministry can be very powerful when it is done well by people who are both trained and gifted by the Spirit. Please inform your prayer groups about this program. Everyone who does regular prayer ministry in groups is expected to attend. Anyone who is interested in growing in prayer ministry is invited to attend. This is a great opportunity to strengthen the impact of the Charismatic Renewal for bringing Jesus' healing and empowerment to people. We want the Archdiocese, your pastors and your staff to know that you have a solid preparation for this ministry.

A good way to prepare for this training is to attend the program by Fr. Bob Sears, S.J. on June 19. See the information in this newsletter.



FROM THE SERVICE COMMITTEE:

Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

We know that our hope is in the Lord who redeemed us and his covenant with us is not temporary but is steadfast. So we as the new Jerusalem must remain focused and obedient to the call to which he has mandated to carry out with all willingness and persevering in all situations and that call is in the gospel of Matthew which says: *“Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.”*

It seems that we are waiting for him to tell us something new or what to do next. But my Brothers and Sisters the call has remained the same. We need to share the Good News to everyone. There will be ample opportunities for us to give witness to someone that is heartbroken, because of a loss in the family. Perhaps a friend of ours who is experiencing marital problems or families in turmoil because of drug addiction, money difficulties or infidelity which are many examples to share God’s love. It isn’t likely that we’ll be called to speak on the street corners, but usually on a person to person basis. Sharing our witness of how God has helped me with my problems and how God can help them with theirs. Jesus said, *“Repent, the kingdom of God is at hand”*. It is now! Take the initiative, ask God to embolden you and use simple words from the heart. Remember, don’t be afraid as it says in Hebrews 13 verse 6, *“Thus we may say in confidence: The Lord is my helper, and I will not be afraid. What can anyone do to me?”* Let’s not be caught gazing up at Jesus as he ascended into heaven as some of the apostles did, but be about the Father’s call to *“Go into the whole world and proclaim the Gospel to every creature.”* (Luke 16:15)

Pentecost - A Fresh Anointing; Go and Make Disciples

One of my favorite songs is *“City of God”*, the lyrics call us to awake from our slumber and that a day is dawning for all those who weep. That day has come and that day is Pentecost!

Over the past thirty seven years Pope Paul VI and John Paul II have on numerous occasions addressed the members of the Catholic Charismatic Renewal Movement. In one of his more recent statements the Holy Father said this: *“Thanks to the Charismatic Movement, many Christians, men, women, youth, have re-discovered Pentecost as a living and present reality in their daily life. I desire that the spirituality of Pentecost be spread in the church, as a renewed thrust of prayer, holiness, communion, and proclamation.”* (May 29, 2004)

We just celebrated Pentecost, what an opportunity to receive the blessing God has for us. Jesus promised the disciples that it would be better for him to leave, in order to fulfill the promise of the Spirit. (John 16:5-7) *“But now I am going to the one who sent me, and not one of you asks me, where are you going? But because I told you this, grief has filled your hearts. But I tell you the truth, it is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you.”*

In the past few years the hierarchy is calling the church to spread the spirituality of Pentecost. How will we do that? The Holy Father stressed prayer, holiness, communion, and proclamation.

The Pope sees that the Charismatic Movement has been raised up by the Lord to help clarify understanding and to fully experience **Life in the Spirit**. The revealed vision of God is that we, like so many in the scriptures, be filled with the Holy Spirit to do the work of the kingdom of God.

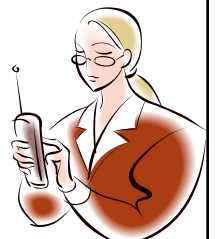

Everyone is invited to attend Fr Bob Sears Family Tree Healing Ministry. *“The ministry has come out of my interest in psychotherapy and theology”*, said Fr Bob Sears. He studied theology and psychotherapy at Fordham University and received his doctorate in 1974. While at Fordham, he got involved in the Catholic Charismatic Renewal, and when he came to Chicago in 1972, he began a prayer group at Longwood Cenacle, which continues today at St. Bernadette’s Parish. Fr Bob taught systematic theology at the Jesuit School of Theology in Chicago, and when it closed in 1981, he joined the faculty at Loyola University’s Institute of Pastoral Studies as adjunct professor. He does part time teaching, writing, pastoral counseling and spiritual direction, and gives workshops and retreats around the country. He is superior of Gonzaga Jesuit Community at Loyola University. He is a past member of the Catholic Theological Society of America and since 1981, a member of the Association of Christian Therapist where he is currently Chaplain of the Board. He enjoys playing guitar and singing, and likes a good round of golf. His publications are *Into the Heart of God: John’s Gospel and Spiritual Development*; *Opening to God: Mary and Life in the Spirit*; *Spirit: Divine and Human. The Theology of the Holy Spirit* and many more...
